


Who We Are

We are dedicated to QUALITY and SUSTAINABLE asphalt pavements.












Who We Represent


OAPC – Roads Scholarship ~ \$90,000.00

Additional \$5,000.00 is budgeted this year to specifically support Women-in-Trades & Technology.












Overview – 2024 Strategic Priorities
